Parking Permit Rules & Regulations

A valid UC Merced parking permit is required to park on campus. Vehicles must be parked in designated locations as authorized by the purchased permit type.

Permit owners are responsible for updating their vehicle information if they get a different vehicle, different license plate number or temporarily drive a different vehicle to campus.

Students should NOT create visitor parking accounts. Visitor parking accounts are intended solely for individuals not associated with UC Merced.

Purchasing a parking permit does not guarantee space availability. The inability to locate a parking space is not considered valid justification for the violation of University parking regulations.
