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## Parking Permit Rules & Regulations

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As a Heritage 'PNR' parking permit holder you are not permitted to park on campus during the following times: Monday through Friday 7am-6pm. If your vehicle is parked on campus during these hours you will be cited. Please note purchasing a kiosk permit does not authorize your vehicle to be parked on campus.

All hanging permits must be face-up, hanging off the rear view mirror, or face-up on the dash board.

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## University Discipline for Permit Abuse

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### Altered and Stolen Permits
