New Toll Free Hotline Numbers for All Incidents

Summary: Find out the new reporting system for auto, general liability, property, and workers compensation incidents.

The new toll free hotline numbers make it <u>easier for you to report an incident.</u> You will be connected directly to UC Merced's Claim Administrator, Sedgwick. Operators are available 24/7.

When should you call a hotline number?

Workers Compensation	All Other Incidents
you suffer a work-related injury, experience a hazardous material exposure, or develop a work- related illness as a result of your UC Merced employment	 you are involved in an auto accident or incident while driving on university business if you are injured be sure to call workers comp number to report injury as well. Loss or damage to university property from any incident including theft.

How should you report it?

Workers Compensation	All Other Incidents
 Report all workers comp events within 24 hours of occurrence Notify your supervisor/manager Obtain an Authorization for Medical Treatment (from your supervisor or Human Resources) if you need to see a doctor Call 1-877-682-7778 Identify yourself by campus, division and department name 	 Report all incidents, injuries, accidents, damage within 24 hours of occurrence Notify your supervisor/manager Gather as much information as possible (including photos) Call 1-800-416-4029 Identify yourself by campus, division and department name

What will Sedgwick do?

Workers Compensation	All Other Incidents
 Ask questions (about yourself, how, when, where, extent of injury, supervisor name, work location, about your job, Occupational Health Clinic (OHC)* or pre-designated physician, etc.) Investigate all incidents Contact all parties involved within 24 hours after you report the incident 	 Ask questions (about yourself, how, when, where, extent of damage, witnesses, vehicle license #s, driver names, etc.) Investigate all incidents Contact all parties involved within 24 hours after you report the incident Determine the cause of the accident and document the extent of damage
